NICENE CREED

SCRIPTURE READING

1 Peter 3:13 - 22

¹³ Who is ^{1a}there to harm you if you prove zealous for what is good? ¹⁴ But even if you should suffer for the sake of righteousness, you ^{1b}are blessed. AND DO NOT FEAR THEIR ^{1c}INTIMIDATION, AND DO NOT BE TROUBLED, ¹⁵ but ^{1d}sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, always *being* ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for

the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence; ¹⁶ and keep a good conscience so that in the thing in which you are slandered, those who revile your good behavior in Christ will be put to shame. ¹⁷ For it is better, if ¹⁸ God should will it so, that you suffer for doing what is right rather than for doing what is wrong. ¹⁸ For Christ also died for sins once for all, *the* just for *the* unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit; ¹⁹ in which also He went and made proclamation to the spirits *now* in prison, ²⁰ who once were disobedient, when the patience of God kept waiting in the days of Noah, during the construction of the ark, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through *the* ²¹ water. ²¹ Corresponding to that, baptism now saves you—not the removal of dirt from the flesh, but an appeal to God for a good conscience—through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, ²² who is at the right hand of God, having gone into heaven, after angels and authorities and powers had been subjected to Him.
