

Corollary

Unified prayer, consecrated, directed, and empowered by the Holy Spirit Is needed to make disciples





Thesis & Corollary Underscore Primary Question

Are church members currently satisfied with their prayer life?



Survey Designed to Probe GMEFC Members' Prayer Life Distributed

- Results
 - 100% of the people responding to this question believed their prayer life could be strengthened
 - Most respondents felt distractions hindered their focus during prayer time
 - Overwhelming majority wanted to improve their prayer life
 - Most respondents thought accountability groups and/or prayer partners would be beneficial
- Grand Marais Prayer Initiative Designed to Meet These Needs & Others Related to Works Being Deemed Complete in God's Sight



Statements Directing Focus of Prayer Initiative

- Guiding Principles Founded in Scripture
- Mission
 - Cultivate an urgency for unified prayer through its committed/disciplined practice
- Vision
 - Holy Spirit-led prayer movement makes disciples & transforms the community by radiating Christ-like character



Dissecting Mission Statement

- Cultivate
 - Spiritual muscle is only built with disciplined exercise
- Committed/Disciplined Practice
 - Participants commit to praying each day for a specified time of their choosing; to documenting their *actual* daily prayer time; and to seeking out accountability partners to help keep focus on their prayer commitments
 - Fasting and/or other prayer sharpening enhancements are encouraged
- Urgency
 - Participants are convicted by the Holy Spirit to spend time of their choice each day focused solely on prayer; become mindful of its power; and, overtime, increasingly desire to exercise that power to the glory of God
- Unified Prayer
 - Focused, Spirit-led prayer on the part of a multitude of God's people has Biblical support as to its power



Dissecting Vision Statement

- Holy Spirit-Led
 - God is glorified through the Holy Spirit's intervention
- Prayer Movement
 - Prayer time, unified focus of prayers, pray-ers, and the power of God displayed through their service grow to an extent that is only attributable to God
- Makes Disciples
 - Unified prayer keeps the church's mission from becoming stagnant and its works complete in God's sight
- Transforms the Community
 - Christ-like character radiates love that attracts others



Prayer Initiative: Program Elements

- Written Commitments of Participants (Personal)
 - Time to be spent each day in focused prayer
 - Maintain records of focused prayer
- Personal & Corporate Accountability
 - Being held accountable helps develop discipline
 - Over time records provide an assessment of personal and corporate growth
- Unified Prayer Guides (aka Prayer Maps)
 - Unified focus in prayer is required to help eliminate distractions that could otherwise hinder growth
 - Created monthly to focus prayers of participants
- Monthly Meeting
 - Discuss experiences and provide input for following month's prayer guide
- Prayer Sharpening Enhancements
 - Small group studies, pastoral teaching, mentoring, & fasting, among others



Beta Test Experience: Pastor & Elders

- Goal
 - Determine whether Prayer Initiative proves beneficial in addressing personal shortcomings in prayer life
- Started December 2020
- Results
 - Personal commitment to daily, unified prayer proved useful in focusing pray-ers attention during the period of time of their chosing
 - Time commitment was generally met or exceeded
 - Journaling proved challenging for some, productive for others
 - Accountability to others helped motivate daily participation
 - Concept of using monthly prayer guides to help focus daily prayers became evident as time progressed
- Consensus
 - Prayer lives of GMEFC faith community will benefit from participation in Prayer Initiative
 - Prayer Initiative will support Church's responsibility in making disciples



Implementation Process & Schedule

- Implementation Process
 - Provide guiding Biblical principles and other background information supporting the Prayer Initiative on GMEFC's website
 - Provide 'tools' on the website to facilitate the Initiative's program accountability elements
 - Conduct informational meetings during 3rd & 4th weeks in February to support the Initiative's implementation
- Schedule
 - Distribute unified prayer guide for March on or before February 28th
 - Initiate program of unified prayer on March 1st



Some Final Comments Today

- No intention of dismantling existing prayer groups
- Commitments required are personal choices and will likely be different for each participant
- Accountability partners are not mandatory, but suggested to help participants achieve the goal of growing in prayer to the glory of God
- Prayer Initiative is not a rigid program; it is meant to evolve and grow as the Holy Spirit directs its participants
- Informational meetings in February will provide added detail about the Initiative; an opportunity to ask questions; and aid in identifying persons interested in serving on a team generating monthly prayer guides
- The Initiative has mid and long term goals that have not been addressed in today's presentation
